

Conference Terms and Conditions

Purpose

(1) These are the Terms and Conditions applicable to all services offered by the Jaipur Model United Nations conference (JMUN), its Secretariats, and Staffs jointly and severally in direct connection or association to JMUN.

(2) In the following, the term “delegation” refers to both: individual delegates and groups of delegates.

(3) In the following, the term "participant" further includes faculty advisers and other observers of conference proceedings.

Registration and Payments

(1) Persons can register either as individuals or as delegations of multiple participants.

(2) Registration via the website is automated and delegations should receive acknowledgement of their application within two weeks of submission. Upon acceptance of an application, the registrant will receive an automated acknowledgement and will have ten days to pay their fees.

(3) Delegations of multiple participants should make payment in one lump sum. Payment information will be e-mailed to the registrant along with notification of acceptance. Applications will be confirmed after the complete amount has been received. The JMUN Foundation will not cover bank charges of any kind.

(4) All fees have to be paid to the JMUN Foundation via Eventzerz after the submission of the online application within ten days. Failure to make payment within this time frame will automatically result in cancellation of the application. In this case it is at the JMUN Secretariats' discretion whether to re-activate an application.

(6) The conferences' fees are indicated in Indian Rupees (INR) per delegate on the relevant conference webpages. In the case of the JMUN conference, there are two Rounds each with their own fees and the fee includes lunch on Saturday and Sunday. Social tickets are not included in the conference fee and will instead be available for sale at a later date.

(7) Should a registrant's application be cancelled due to failure to make payment within ten days of acceptance, they will be able to re-register.

(8) All registrations are done on a first come, first served basis. Due to limited availability at our conference venue, we cannot guarantee that applications will be accepted throughout the advertised registration process.

(9) No delegate is entitled to a refund.

Liability

(1) Participants are expected and obliged to obey the laws of the Republic of India while participating in the events of the JMUN Foundation. Participants are personally responsible for all charges and damages to facilities of the conference and social events venues.

(2) The JMUN Foundation does not provide liability insurance for the protection of individuals or groups who participate in the conference.

(3) Each individual and group agreeing to these Terms and Conditions releases and discharges the JMUN Foundation, its Secretariats, and Staffs jointly and severally from any and all actions, causes of actions, claims, liabilities, costs, obligations and demands, including without limitation attorneys' fees and expenses for, upon or by reason of loss, damage, injury, or death, which hereafter may be sustained by participating in any activities connected with the JMUN Foundation. This involves especially compensation, in part or in whole, for losses, damages, injuries or death incurred at or in connection with the JMUN Foundation.

(4) The JMUN Foundation will not offer any services to minors without an express release of liability signed by a parent or legal guardian. No refunds will be made to minors who fail to demonstrate a signed accident waiver by a parent or legal guardian upon registration at the conference venue.

(5) The JMUN Foundation reserves the right to exclude specific individuals or groups of individuals from its offered services. The JMUN Foundation excludes any legal actions on the side of the individual or group of individuals related to a possible exclusion. No exclusions shall be made on grounds including but not limited to gender identity, race, sexual orientation, religion or national origin.

Country and Committee Assignments

(1) Country and committee assignments will take place at a time indicated on the relevant webpage. Priority in assignments will be given on the basis of past performance and early registrations. Submission of preferences is not a guarantee of receiving preferences, and all decisions of the JMUN and JMUN: HS Secretariats with regard to country assignments are final. The registration fee may not be refunded even if a delegation does not accept its country assignment.

(2) The JMUN Secretariats reserves the right to remove allocations from an already assigned country in the event that the delegation fails to fill all the assigned allocations by the advertised deadline.

(3) Individual delegates are expected to be in their respective committee rooms during committee sessions. In order for delegates to leave their committee rooms for an extended period of time, their Chair must be informed ahead of time.

(4) All delegates are expected to abide by the committee dress code (business attire).

(5) Delegates who do not participate in 3/5 of the committee sessions are not eligible for Certificates of Participation.

Smoking, Alcohol and Drug Policy

(1) Participants will not be permitted to smoke inside any of the conference venues.

(2) Open containers of alcohol may not be carried around in committee rooms and hallways at the conference venue.

(3) Participants found possessing or using illicit drugs, as defined by Indian law, during the conference or at social events will be required to leave immediately and may be held criminally liable.

Expulsion from the Conference

(1) The JMUN Foundation reserves the right to immediately expel participants from both the conference and the conference venues due to unacceptable behaviour or violation of these Terms and Conditions. The Secretariats reserve the right to define
